

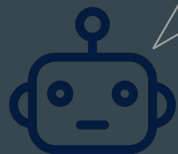

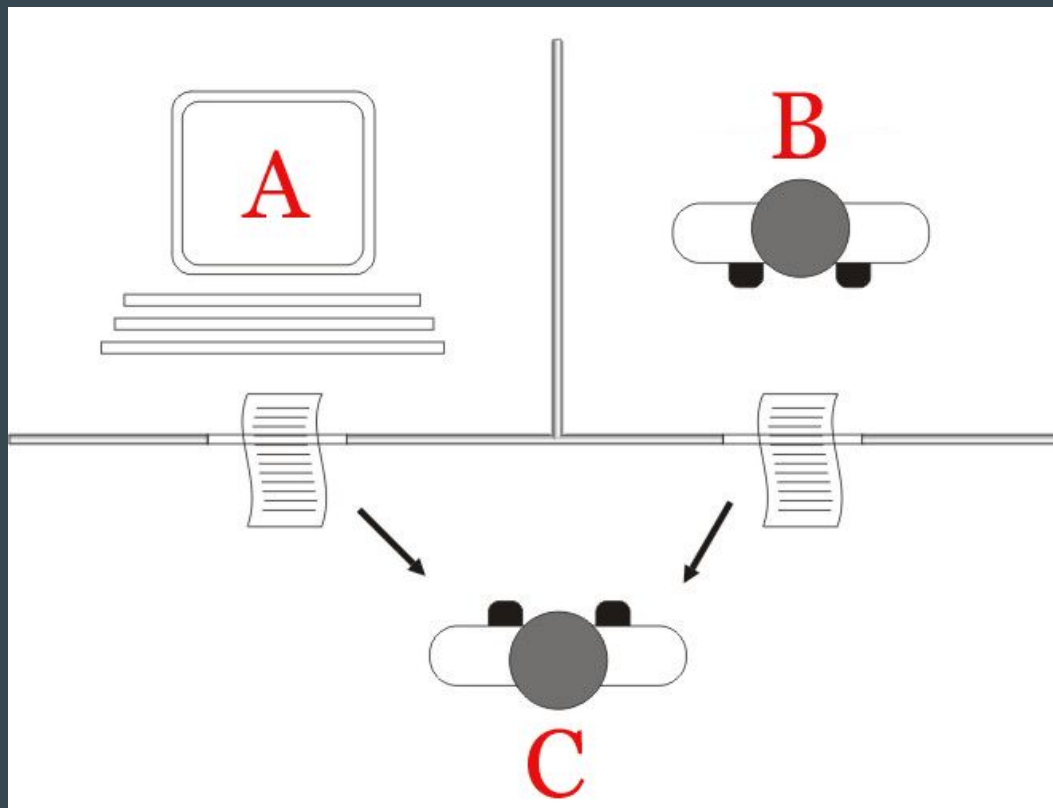

# History of Chatbots - Early work

ELIZA (1966): Virtual “therapist”

<https://www.masswerk.at/elizabot/>

Search for keywords and transform question in to response

PARRY (1972): Paranoid Schizophrenic

Advanced modelling of conversation and behaviour. ELIZA with attitude

ELIZA: Good Evening. Tell me your problems. Please terminate input with a period or a question mark.

PARRY: People get on my nerves sometimes.

ELIZA: I am not sure I understand you fully.

PARRY: You should pay more attention.

ELIZA: Suppose you should pay more attention.

PARRY: You're entitled to your own opinion.

ELIZA: What makes you think I am entitled to my own opinion?

PARRY: It bothers me just to be around people in general.

ELIZA: Please go on.

# History of Chatbots - More sophisticated examples

A.L.I.C.E. (Artificial Linguistic Internet Computer Entity, 1995): More sophisticated pattern matching, but very similar to ELIZA

Inspiration for movie HER

Jabberwacky (1997): Stores everything everyone has ever said, and finds the most appropriate thing to say using contextual pattern matching techniques.

Cleverbot (2008): Larger database, with more sophisticated search algorithm to Jabberwacky.

Siri, Alexa, etc...: Spoken language parser -> Cleverbot with massive database

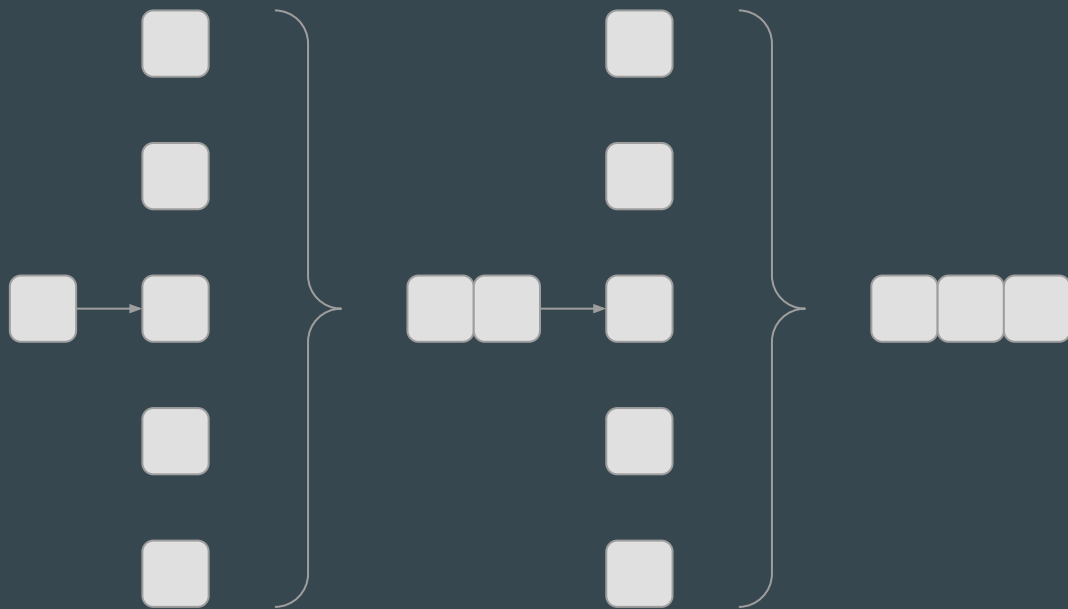

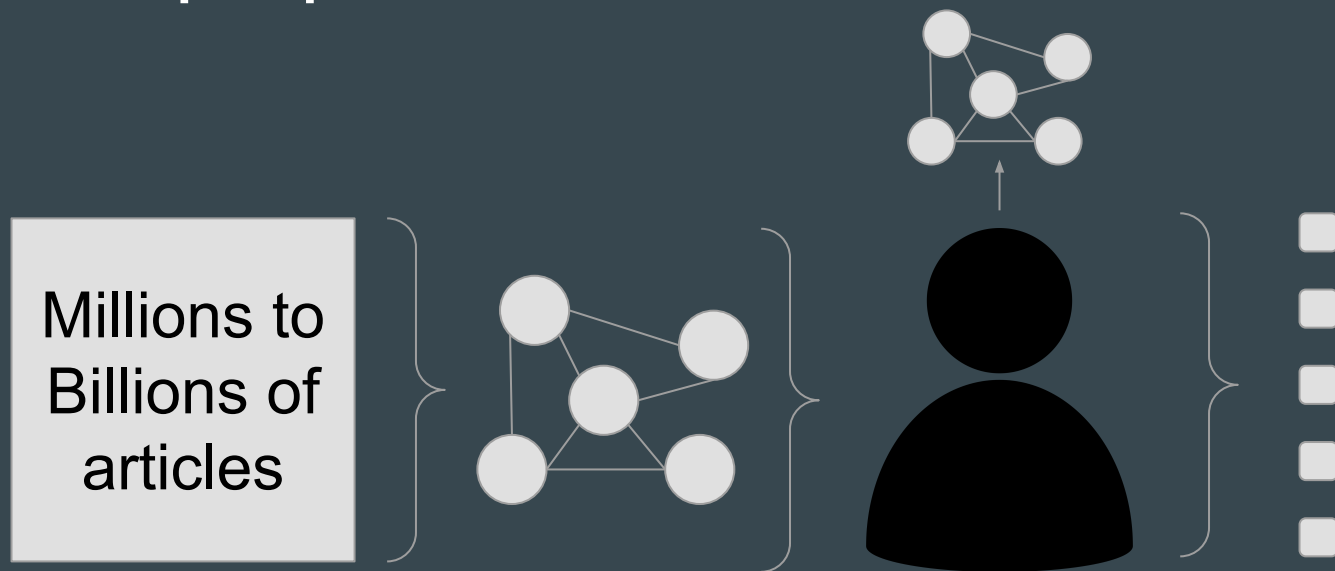

# Pitfalls

1. ChatGPT is very confident
2. ChatGPT is not connected to the internet
3. ChatGPT is trained up to September 2021
4. ChatGPT is expensive to run so is sometimes slow or unavailable
5. ChatGPT is restricted
